

Chapter 12. Word order transformations.

Rearrange the words of each of the following clauses so that it has the indicated word order. Try to be aware of how elements other than S and V should be arranged to make the clause idiomatic. Example:

þā se ceorl ofslōh þone cyning (S . . . V)

þā se ceorl þone cyning ofslōh

10. hē þā hine mid his handa genam (VS)
